MEET DETAILS

VENUE	Dayboro Pool and Gym - 35 Williams Street, Dayboro QLD 4521
TIME	Gates open 8am Warm Up – 8:15am Start – 9:00am There is no warmup / warm down pool during the meet.
AGE	Age as of Sunday 9th November 2025 - 6 to 15 years.
ELIGIBILITY	This meet is open to the following clubs – Albany Creek, Dayboro, Ferny Hills, Lawnton, Pine Rivers and Samford.
NOMINATIONS	Cost - \$9 per Event. Spectators Free and Relays Free. Online entry only via Swim Central close 11.59pm 30th October 2025 https://swimcentral.swimming.org.au NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 30TH OCTOBER 2025 Swimmers can enter in their club's relay team at the end of the meet. Relay teams will be organised on the day.
EVENTS	• Our Transition meet is a friendly meet and due to the size of our pool, we had to combine our sessions. Participation is capped at 125 swimmers and age to 15 years. Instead of including 200m events, we included a fun interclub relay event at the end of the day. • As per the attached Program of Events on next page. Swimmers can only enter 1 event per stroke in either 25m and 50m. All events are to be swum as timed finals. Heats will be ran fastest to slowest. All races except for backstroke will be started “over the top”. Refunds will be issued and processed through Swim Central if notification of the withdrawal is received prior to nomination closing time. After nomination closing time refunds will only be issued due to a medical reason and a medical certificate has been supplied.
RELAYS	4 x 25m Freestyle Age Relay – 8 & U, 12 & U, 15 & U. (Junior, Intermediate and Senior) Girls can swim as boys; boys cannot swim as girls. We will enter 2 relay teams for each age group from each club. Clubs will need to update their relay teams on the day. Clubs can nominate a swimmer from another club to make up a team. No diving into the shallow end, swimmers must be in the water with a hand on the wall for the start of their swim in the relays. (2nd and 4th Swimmer)

AWARDS	Medals will be awarded to the fastest 3 placegetters in the following age groups: • 100m Events – 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 years. • 25m events - 6, 7, 8, 9 years. • 50m events – 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 years. Ribbons will be awarded to the top 3 place getters in the relay 4 x 25m Freestyle Age Relay - 8&U, 12&U, 15&U.
RULES	• This meet will be conducted under SQ/SAL Rules. • An entry list will be emailed to all competitors for checking, prior to the meet. • Clubs will be allocated time keeping duties. Semi- automatic timekeeping and manual timekeeping will be used.
